There's always going to be electricity surrounding us...

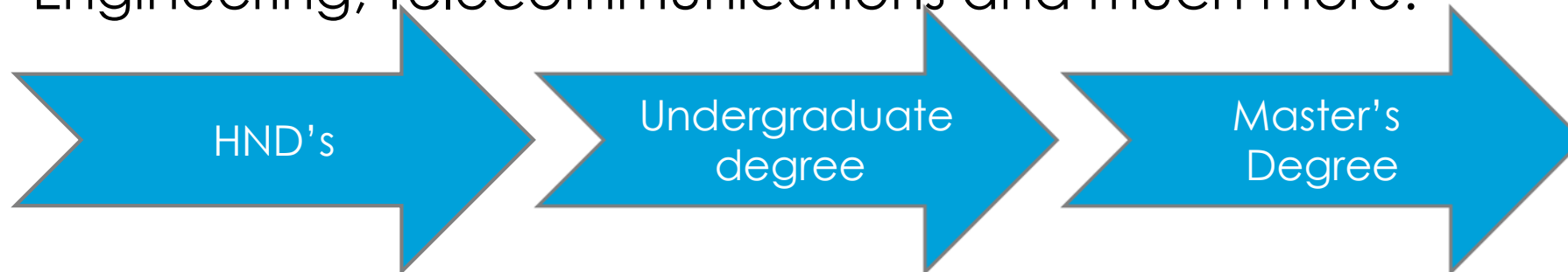
- SMART technologies – we live in an increasingly wireless world

There are different types of electricians...

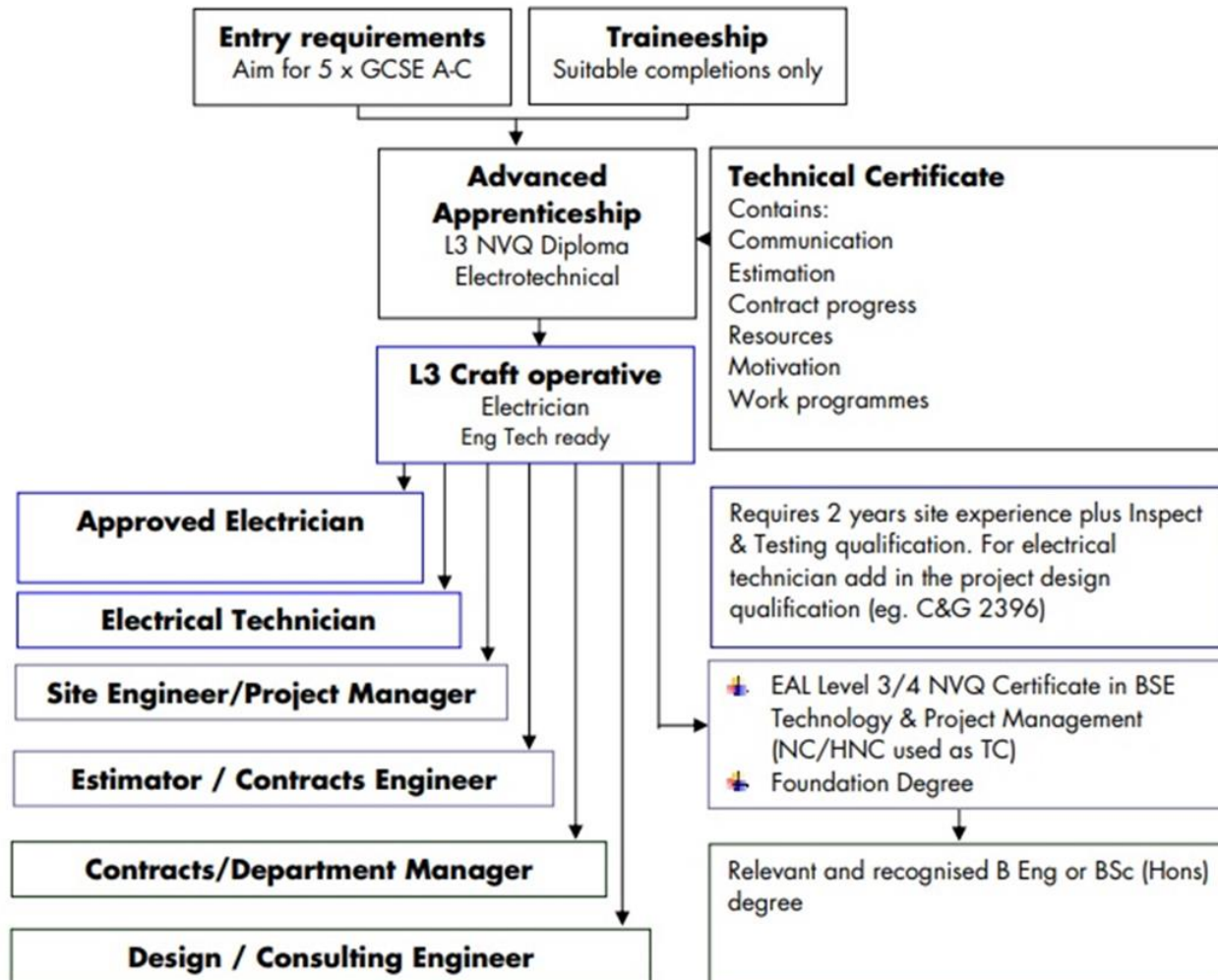
- Installation & Maintenance

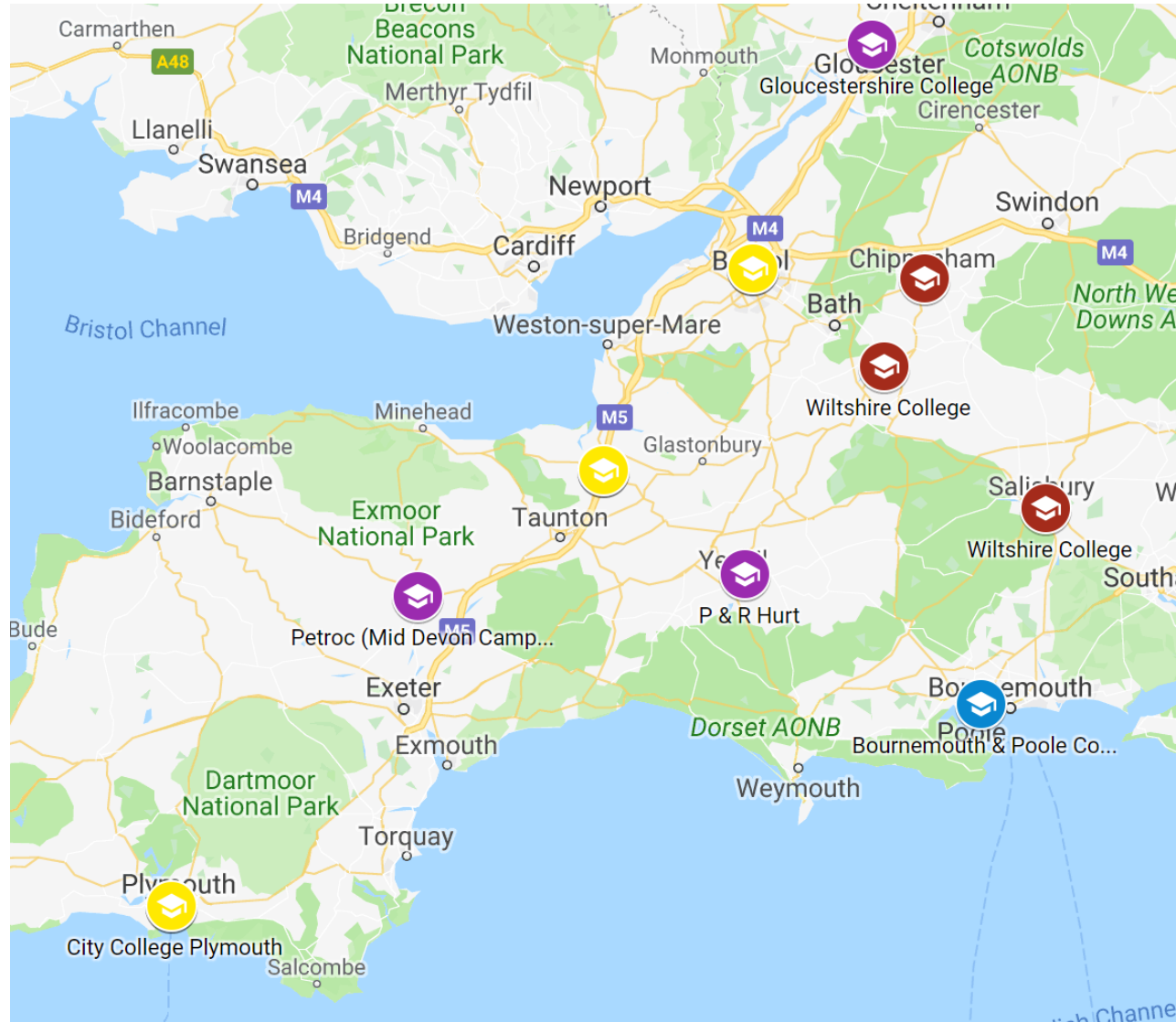
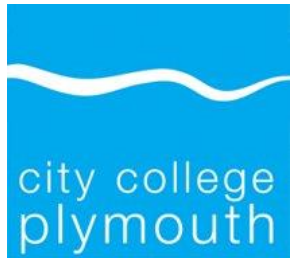
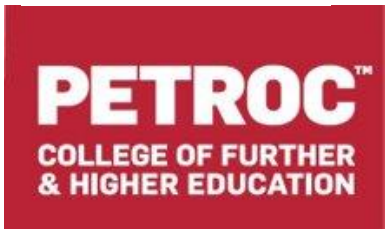


Which direction could they go?

Step 1:

Complete the registration and the online assessments

There are 3 assessments, literacy, numeracy and aptitude, which all need to be passed.

Step 2:

Electricians cannot be colour blind, therefore each applicant needs to take a colour blind test.

An appointment with an optician needs to be made, and JTL's colour blind certificate needs to be filled in. This can be found on our website:

The completed certificate will need to be sent to our National Administration Centre.

Step 3:

Finally, before becoming approved, each applicant must have a telephone discussion with a member of our recruitment team at the National Administration Centre.
